## 1. Qatar National Library By Car

\* The Library is located in Education City and is easily accessible **by car**.

\* Please note that parking spaces near the Library are limited. We recommend parking at the Oxygen Park underground car park or the car park next to the Education City Mosque, then taking the **free Education City Tram** to the Multaqa (Student Center) station, located near the Library.
